This international course will provide you with the fundamental aspects related to the logistics and mobility in Madrid, the third largest city in Europe. In order to achieve this goal, it is essential to focus on the main transport infrastructures that support the city. We will be visiting other historical cities to compare them with a megacity and their emblematic places. In addition, we will work on projects analysing study areas with critical mobility. In this sense it is necessary to offer creative and sustainable solutions based on a rigorous diagnosis.

This course is for anyone interested in expanding their global vision in mobility management, transport logistics, and comparing megacities and historical cities with emblematic centres. Now especially with the Covid-19 crisis, there are a number of possible futures, all of which are dependent on how society responds to the economic and cultural aftermath. Hopefully, we will use this situation to rebuild and produce a better and more humane world.

Madrid has excellent transport links with other Spanish cities, and indeed with the rest of Europe and beyond. The 0-mile in the heart of the city is the hub of the Spanish highways and allows you to travel to any area you would like with ease. UCJC is the first university in Spain that offers studies in Transport and Logistics.

Contents

First week

Presentation, master classes, technical visits to mobility and logistics infrastructures, technical visits to transport centres, technical visits to traffic control centres and visits to historical cities to learn about their logistics and modes of mobility.

Second week

Work on projects, methodology, measurement tools workshop, analysis tools workshop, measurement campaign, recognition of critical zones, diagnosis and results, proposal of sustainable solutions, discussion, final presentation.
